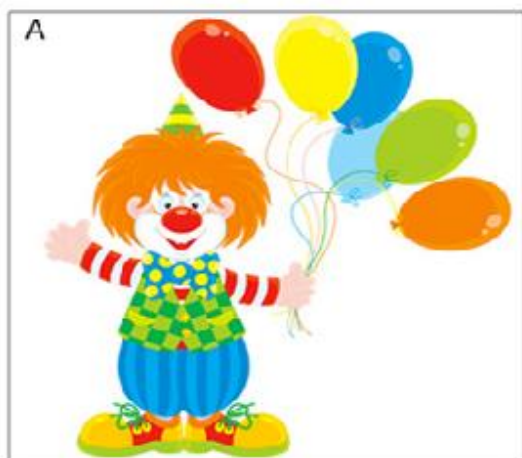

7. You warrant that you are the sole copyright owner and author of each entry.
8. You agree to participate in related publicity for the purposes of advertising, promotion and publicity and for your name and image/s to be used indefinitely without additional compensation.
9. Entries must comply with Submission Requirements outlined below.
10. All participants must be under the age of 13 on 30th July, 2021
