Lugarno Public School has formed the Lugarno Public School Building Fund and has been endorsed by the Australian Taxation Office as a Deductible Gift Recipient. This means that if you make a donation of \$2 or more to the Lugarno Public School Building Fund the donation will be tax deductible.



What is the Lugarno School Building Fund and how will it help the school?

The primary focus of the Lugarno Public School Building Fund is to seek donations from the public, past, present and future families of Lugarno Public School to help with the construction, improvement and maintenance of school buildings at Lugarno. This will supplement the current school funding.

Some examples of how Lugarno Public School plans to use the funds donated to benefit the school:

- Refreshing the school with painting to school buildings and classrooms;
- New carpets in classrooms; and
- Upgrading the canteen, library and computer rooms.



How will the School Building Fund Operate?

The Fund is operated by the School Building Fund Administrator, an elected position of the school P & C.

The Lugarno Public School Building Fund committee includes our Principal Justine Williams and four other P&C members. The Committee will seek donations from the public and use the funds to improve and maintain the school buildings at Lugarno Public School.
