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GRANTS/PROJECTS

- Last year we were successful in being approved for \$5,256 in the 2020 Community Building Partnership Grant via Mark Coure's Office. This grant was for a revamp of the student toilet blocks. Part 1 has now been completed which involved replacing all the taps to 'time flow' ones to enable students to more easily wash their hands without having to have one hand on the tap. Part 2 will involve the toilet doors being decorated with motivational/inspirational pictures and messages. We are seeking volunteers to be involved in this project and to assist with the work. If you are interested in being involved, perhaps you are artistic/handy/ creative or just happy to help out with non-creative stuff, then please get in touch to be part of the working group. 


