# Welcome back!

Welcome to the 2023 school year. It was wonderful to see so many happy faces when I visited classrooms today and see our students already hard at work and settled. Great job LPS students!

I am excited about the year ahead and continuing to build on the great learning and opportunities afforded to our students at LPS.

I warmly welcome our new families to the school. We look forward to having you as part of the LPS community. We are also looking forward to our Kinder 2023 students visiting this week for their Best Start Assessment and then officially commencing on Monday, 6<sup>th</sup> February.

# 2023 Classes

Today our students have returned to their 2022 classes. Enrolments have fluctuated since the end of last year and we are waiting for them to stabilise over the next few days. We hope to form classes as soon as possible – most likely on Monday, 6<sup>th</sup> February. You will be updated when the class formation has occurred.

A complete list of 2023 LPS staff and classes will be issued next week.

A great deal of time, effort and thought has already gone into the process of student placement for the 2023 school year. Careful consideration has been given to the best placement for each individual. Classes will be balanced academically and socially. Our class groupings will be structured to provide equitable class sizes at each stage level and combinations of students most conducive to learning.

Once our 2023 classes are formed, I urge all parents to be positive with your child about their new class and their new teacher and help him or her understand that it is impossible to place all students with a preferred best friend or teacher. ALL of our teachers work hard to make school a positive experience for ALL students. Our teachers are highly experienced in teaching a range of class structures (including stage/multi-age classes) and are eagerly looking forward to working with your child/ren. Please be mindful that it can take a few weeks for a child to acclimate to a new class, peer group and teacher. We ask that you are positive about your child's new class when it is established and give your child the chance to settle in.

# **Uniform Shop**

Thank you to our Uniform Shop Coordinator, Janette Allardyce-Walker who has worked tirelessly to facilitate this service to our community and opened up in the school holidays to assist with uniform purchasing. Our Unform Shop will reopen on Thursday morning from 8.30-9.30am in the school hall. Like last year, uniform orders can also be placed online using the Qkr! App. When orders have been processed, they will be sent home with your child. Orders that have been processed and are ready for new Kindergarten students can be collected from the front office on the day of your child's allocated Best Start Assessment time.

Here is an overview of the required uniform each day:

Monday - All students in full school uniform

Tuesday – K-2 students in sports uniform; 3-6 students in full school uniform

Wednesday – All students in full school uniform

Thursday – All students in sports uniform

Friday – K-2 students in full school uniform; 3-6 students in sports unform.
