



Stage 3 Camp Requirements 2024

4 July 2024

Our school camp to Bathurst is drawing closer. The camp will take place in Term 3 Week 4 from Wednesday 14 August to Friday 16 August 2024.

Please find following a list of items that each student will need to bring along with them.

You will need **recess and lunch** in your small day pack for the first day:

- 1 travelling case and 1 small day pack
- Warm clothes for 2 days, including a warm jacket (no singlet tops or midriff tops) socks and underwear (clean change for each day at least)
- sunscreen and hat
- toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, brush, shampoo, deodorant)
- wet weather jacket
- a towel
- sleeping bag
- pillowcase (everyone needs one even if you take a sleeping bag)
- a pair of comfortable joggers to wear with an additional pair for emergency.
- pyjamas
- a plastic bag for dirty clothes/shoes
- water bottle (to take along to all activities)
- handkerchiefs or tissues

Optional items –

- camera
- torch
- book to read
- playing cards
- spending money: For souvenirs (approx. \$20 - \$30)

All items, especially socks and underwear as well as toiletries and luggage bags must be clearly labelled with your name.

DO NOT BRING – jewellery, electronic games, devices with a SIM card (including Smart watches), school uniform or anything valuable. The school will not be liable for any damage or loss.

Remember that you are responsible for your luggage. If cannot carry it on your own, please organise it so you can.

Included in this package is the itinerary. PLEASE NOTE: the bus departs the school at 8:00 am on the Wednesday and is due back approximately 4 pm on the Friday. A more accurate time of arrival will be communicated on the day via the *Sentral for Parents* App.

All staff members have emergency care training. Accompanying staff are Mr Finneran, Mrs Harris, Mr Walker and Mrs Targett.

Please note that if your child requires any medication/vitamins throughout the three days at camp, you will need to hand it to your child's teacher, discuss the procedure, (if you haven't done so already) and it should only be enough for the three days.

It must be in its original packaging and clearly marked with the student's name, the advised dosage and the dosage interval. This should have already been noted on the pink medical consent form.

All medication needs to be collected prior to getting on the bus. Please find Mrs Harris on the morning of or if you can, drop it off on Monday to save time.
