

Scenic Pass is a Teacher Guided experience providing access to all of the Scenic World attractions. Take in World heritage panoramas with a return trip between clifftops on the Scenic Skyway. Descend into the Jamison Valley on the Scenic Railway, the world's steepest train. Stroll under the canopy of an extraordinary temperate rainforest on the 10-

minute, 30-minute or 50-minute Scenic Walkway boardwalk.

Village Treasure Hunt, Bald Hill Underground Mind & Gold Panning incl

Enjoy a walk around Hill End Village with a guide in period costume. Walk 80 meters into the Bald Hill Underground Mine to learn about the mining methods of the gold rush. Students can see for themselves the quartz reefs and the geology of the mine. Finish with Gold Panning in Tambaroora Creek in the same way as the hopeful miners. Meeting Point: The National Park picnic ground, take the first left after entering Hill End. There is coach parking, toilets and a picnic area. A Hill End Ranch representative will meet you with itineraries for Teachers and maps for the coach driver.
