Students Enrolling and Departing

We appreciate the families who have informed us of their plans and school changes for next year. It has been helpful as we work through the class formation process. Please email the school if you will be leaving the school at the end of the year. We are still accepting enrolments for 2022 from Kindergarten to Year 6. Please let your family and friends know that if they are seeking enrolment at the school for 2022, they need to contact our school as soon as possible.

Kindergarten Transition for 2022 students – 'Leap Into Lugarno' Transition

Program

We are looking forward to the third and final session of our "Leap Into Lugarno" Kindergarten transition program tomorrow, Wednesday 1st December.

Please access our designated drop-off and collection point at your child's allocated time through the large double gates on Lugarno Parade. For COVID safety, we request adults wear a face mask while dropping off and picking up students. As per current Department of Education directives, only one fully vaccinated adult is to accompany each child/family to the transition visits. We ask that you sign in using the QR codes attached to the gates and provide proof of vaccination status on request. We will also confirm your child is well before entry. This may include signing of enrolment forms. The 2022 Kindergarten students will then be taken to the classrooms for their orientation and transition activities.

When you drop your child off, could you please ensure they have a labelled backpack containing a water bottle, a small container of chopped fruit or vegetables and a change of clothing in case of an unforeseen toileting accident.

For your convenience, we will once again have a uniform display at the drop off point for you to view the various uniform options and make an online order. An information pack/"showbag" will also be given to each child.

We look forward to parents joining us for our next parent information session at 5pm via Zoom on Thursday, 2nd December.

Class Placement 2022

If you have any specific information that the school needs to be aware of in regards to your child's class placement for 2022, this needs to be put in writing and addressed to the Principal as soon as possible. Please be aware that requests for placement with specific teachers will not be considered except in exceptional circumstances.

If you provided information in relation to previous school years, please be aware that you will need to contact us again in relation to the 2022 school year as these considerations are looked at annually.

Morning Supervision and Morning Drop Offs

A friendly reminder that there is no teacher supervision before 8.30am. We have had a number of children arriving well before 8.30am this week. Please refrain from sending students prior to 8.30am. If you require before school supervision/care, please book in with our OOSH facility. Bookings can be made by calling ph: 0411 137 833.

Morning drop offs – Please ensure K-2 students are dropped off between 8.30-8.50am and enter through the Lugarno Parade gate.

Please ensure students in 3-6 are dropped off between 8.30-8.50am and enter through the Old Forest Rd gate.

Any students who arrive after the 8.50am bell, need to enter through the front office to obtain a late pass. Please ensure that if your child is late, that a note or email explaining the reason for your child's lateness is sent to the school.

Drop off and pick up COVID safety

We are using a staggered pick-up schedule and multiple exit points to minimise the congregation of parents and families outside the school. Could you please help keep our community safe by not lingering after the school bell and exit the pickup zone as quickly as possible. Thank you.

- 1 3/4 cups self-raising flour sifted
- 1/2 cup milk choc bits
- 1/2 cup white choc bits
- 1 1/4 cups milk
- 75 g butter melted
- 1 cup Milo

Important Update for Parents and Carers

Dear parents and carers,

In order to minimise disruptions caused to schools by COVID-19 cases, and to maximise the time our students have learning in the classrooms a number of changes to operations for schools will be introduced from Monday 29 November for the remainder of Term 4.

Rapid antigen 'test-to-stay' program

A rapid antigen home testing (RAHT) 'test-to-stay' program will be available to any student who is a close contact of a COVID-19 case in a school setting. This will enable them to get back to school immediately following a negative PCR test and on the basis they do daily RAHTs before attending school across 7 consecutive days. This means that our students' learning is able to continue with minimal interruptions following a positive COVID-19 case. Full support will be available to help you implement this should it be required at our school and many other schools and students are already using RAHTs successfully.

An update to our cleaning protocols

NSW public schools are cleaned by professional cleaners each day, guided by expert advice from the Australian Health Protection Principal Committee (AHPPC), the National Health and Medical Research Council and NSW Health. As we have already seen in many schools, cohorting and our other COVID-safe layers of protection have been effective at minimising disruption. NSW Heath has provided clear advice, based on evidence that the department's regular clean, day clean and enhanced clean provides a more than sufficient layer of protection in schools for students and staff. NSW Health have advised there is no health and safety benefit to undertaking an environmental clean which is highly disruptive to a school's ongoing operations and can close a school for up to 2 days. This is another important change that will get students back into classrooms faster in parallel with the 'test-to-stay' program. You can read more on the department's <u>website</u> about the different levels of cleaning in place in our schools.

Student attendance at school

- All students are expected to be at school unless they are unwell. Do not attend school if unwell, even with mild symptoms. Get tested for COVID-19 and follow NSW Health directions. Find your local <u>testing clinics</u>.
- If you have any COVID-19 symptoms you will be sent home and must not return to school unless you have either:
 - $_{\odot}$ isolated for 10 days, when no medical certificate is available
 - a negative COVID-19 test result and are symptom free.
- In circumstances where a student has other medical reasons for recurrent symptoms, a letter from your GP is sufficient to negate the requirement for a negative test.
- Self-isolation periods and testing requirements differ for close contacts based on their exposure and vaccination status. Refer to <u>NSW Health's advice for close contacts</u> for more information.

• Rapid antigen home testing might be an option for students and school-based staff to return to face-to-face learning and teaching. Refer to the department's <u>Response protocols</u> for more information.

COVID-safe measures at school

A combination of layered safety measures – vaccination, wearing masks, student cohorting, physical distancing, ventilation, hygiene and cleaning - allows us to prioritise student and staff wellbeing while we keep schools operational.

Assemblies and presentations

Assemblies and presentations will be allowed outdoors on site. Cohorts will be separated with physical distancing in place where practicable. Fully vaccinated visitors (including parents and carers) are only allowed to attend if **invited by the school to complete a specific role (such as presenting)**.

As per the guidelines above, our presentation day, Kinder and Year 6 graduation assemblies have been modified to comply with the guidelines.

Our presentation day assemblies will be in stage-based cohort groups for Stages 1, 2 and 3 and will be a **student and staff event only**. As we will be proceeding with stage-based presentation day assemblies in existing cohort groups, our assemblies will take place in the school hall.

The presentation day assemblies scheduled for Thursday 9th December will be filmed for parents to view. We hope to have these videos available on Monday, 13th December. The Kindergarten Graduation Assembly scheduled for Friday, 10th December will also be a student and staff event only and will again be filmed for parents, with the film being made available on Monday, 13th December.

Based on the current guidelines, the Year 6 Graduation Assembly on the last day of term on Thursday, 16th December will also be a student and staff event only. This will be held via Zoom and the students across the school will engage in a "clap out" of our Year 6 students and any exiting students. The clap out will be done in front of each class or on the class verandah prior to dismissal. Our annual presentation of small gifts to our departing families will be incorporated into the Zoom assembly, with gifts sent home with students.

We understand that this is disappointing for parents who would like to join us at school for the celebrations, but based on the current guidelines for all schools, we are unable to proceed as normal this year.

2021 NSW PREMIER'S READING CHALLENGE

Premiers Reading Challenge closed at the end of August and certificates will be distributed later in the year. Congratulations, to all of K-2 as they have all qualified for a certificate this year and to those avid 3-6 readers who have logged their own books and completed the challenge again. All Gold, bronze and platinum will be presented at this year's presentation day. Well done!

Kids Teaching Kids conference 2021

Lugarno Public School was fortunate enough to be invited to the 2021 Kids Teaching Kids Conference. The Kids Teaching Kids program has been running for over 22 years. The aim of the program is to promote positive wellbeing and help build resilience in young people. It raises awareness and drives action on local and global environmental issues, bringing communities together to solve common challenges and help our students to become leaders who will take collective responsibility for our future.

We were invited as a presenter for the Minecraft Education world we built that included Indigenous perspectives in our local area. Our world focused on H.V. Evatt Park, Glenlee Farm and the Georges River. Our first entry into the Indigital program was very successful and based on this we received an invitation to adapt our Minecraft Education World to focus more on the Georges River and an issue that was impacting the water quality. The Stage 3 students in this group researched major causes of pollution in the Georges River and discovered the main cause was from storm water runoff. They decided to build gross pollution traps (GPTs) into the world to filter rubbish along the river.

This program required the students to create a lesson that would demonstrate the impact of pollution in the river, teach the lesson through a video recording and then brainstorm an idea to leave an 'action legacy plan' for Lugarno Public School. The students decided on a 'rainwater garden' to help filter pollution before it reaches the storm water on our school property and drafted a plan to put this in place for 2022.

The students enjoyed listening to guest speakers Eddie Betts, Costa Georgiadis & Lucy Skelton and their inspirational stories about leadership, the environment and sustainability and most importantly how one person can make a difference.
