We were fortunate to also have special guests, Simon Kolb and Hannah Gentle visit us. Simon Kolb is the Global Manager for the Swarovski Water School program, and lives in Austria. He has travelled to all the way to Australia to evaluate the Swarovski Water School Australia program, to visit us at Lugarno PS and to attend the Swarovski Water School flagship event next week.

Hannah Gentle is the Program Manager for Education at Earthwatch and manages the Swarovski Water School program here in Australia. Hannah visited Lugarno PS earlier this year to help create our water education peer-teaching workshops and will host the Flagship Event next week where students from across NSW (including our Semester 2 Stage 3 enrichment group) will meet at the Georges River Environmental Education Centre to teach one another about their local water challenges and inspire collective action to help overcome them.

This initiative has been an exciting one for our Stage 3 staff and students. Led by our highly dynamic and innovative Teacher Librarian, Mrs Dufty, our students have had access to rich real-world learning, an opportunity to collaborate, think creatively and critically, explore sustainability issues in relation to their local context and share this important learning with others. I commend the outstanding work Mrs Dufty, our Stage 3 students and staff have done as part of this project and it was wonderful to showcase it to parents in the library last Friday afternoon.

Chicken fajita roll-ups

0.5 serves of vegetables per tortilla Diet and Allergies: Nut Free

Ingredients



¹⁄₂ avocado, mashed
¹⁄₂ avocado, mashed
100g cooked chicken, finely chopped
2 tsp our Healthy Taco Seasoning Mix (see recipe)
4 wholemeal tortillas
¹⁄₂ cup reduced-fat cheddar cheese, grated
1 cup lettuce, finely shredded
¹⁄₂ carrot, peeled, finely grated
¹⁄₄ green capsicum, finely sliced
¹⁄₂ tbsp spring onion, finely chopped

Healthy Taco Seasoning Mix:
1 tsp garlic powder
1 tsp onion powder
1 tsp dried oregano
2 tsp paprika
6 tsp ground cumin
2 tsp salt
½ tsp ground pepper

Method

To make the Healthy Taco Seasoning, mix everything together in a small bowl. This recipe makes bulk seasoning, store in an airtight container until required.

Combine the avocado and 1 teaspoon taco seasoning in a bowl. Combine the chicken and another teaspoon of the taco seasoning in a separate bowl.

Working with 2 tortillas at a time, place in the microwave for 20 seconds on high to soften.

Evenly spread the tortillas with the avocado mix, sprinkle with cheese, chicken, lettuce, carrot, capsicum and spring onion. Roll up tightly. Place seam side down on a tray and repeat with remaining tortillas.

Inclusive, Engaging and Respectful; Schools Package

New policies, procedures and framework to keep students engaged in learning at school

The Inclusive, Engaging and Respectful (IER) Schools package was announced in February this year by NSW Minister for Education and Early Learning, Hon Sarah Mitchell.

It centres on three new policies and procedures and a framework that together set the guidelines for how we ensure all children and young people can learn through public education in a safe and engaging way. The IER Schools package includes the:

- ✓ Inclusive Education Policy for students with disability
- ✓ Student Behaviour Policy and Procedures
- ✓ Restrictive Practices Framework and Restrictive Practices Reduction and Elimination Policy and Procedures.

With these new policies, we want all students to:

- be included in all aspects of school life and supported to learn to their fullest capability
- be supported in engaging, respectful, and effective classrooms with positive and inclusive practices
- feel welcomed, valued and safe in our schools and classroom

Two of the policies are new: the Inclusive Education Policy; and the Restrictive Practices Framework and policy. Both clarify *existing* legal obligations, effective, appropriate and prohibited practices, and the rights of students, parents and carers.

The Student Behaviour Policy replaces the Student Discipline in Government Schools and Suspension and Expulsion Policy. The key change is the approach all NSW public schools will take to address disruptive or inappropriate behaviour by a student. The duration of a suspension will be reduced along with the number of suspensions across a school year. Every school will be able to draw on the support of a range of staff including behaviour specialists to effectively address issues resulting in these behaviours in order to prevent future escalations. We will continue to work closely with you and all our families.

It does not mean, however, that students who are violent or seriously disrupt the learning and wellbeing of others will be kept at school. Any student who puts the safety of other students, teachers and staff or visitors at risk of harm – will be suspended until it is safe for them to return.

The Inclusive Education Policy for students with disability and the Student Behaviour Policy become operational in Term 4, 2022 and the Restrictive Practices Policy becomes operational in Term 1, 2023.

The staff and I are reviewing our current approach to all of the areas covered by these policies, and wish to share any changes we believe need to made with you in the near future.

Our school already takes a strong, positive student-centred approach, but we want to work with you to ensure, together, every student has the right support at the right time to help them grow into confident, resilient adults.

Ethics classes at Lugarno Public School in 2023

The demand for Ethics classes at LPS continues to grow.

We now need volunteers to step forward so that children in all stages who have expressed an interest in attending Ethics, can participate in the program in 2023. Please be aware the classes cannot run without volunteers. We need three volunteer teachers, one of whom will take on the role of coordinator.

Could you or someone you know be an Ethics teacher for Lugarno Public School? Don't be put off by the title – the job involves facilitating a discussion with the children!
