The canteen is open every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday for lunch orders. Place your order via QKR! by 9:15am. A late lunch order option is available after 9:15am up until 11:30am with a limited menu available. If your child comes to the canteen without lunch, our volunteers have a School approved process to follow, this ensures no child goes hungry. Should this happen, a note will be sent home with your child with details on how to make payment. Please ensure you are selecting the correct date for your child's lunch order, as we have had an increase in the number of children presenting without lunch.

Due to circumstances beyond the canteens control, you may notice that some items become unavailable. Our suppliers are also having issues with stock supply. Thank you for understanding.

Don't forget about the Friday Ice Block competition. Place an order on Fridays to be in the running, these will be drawn randomly throughout the term.
