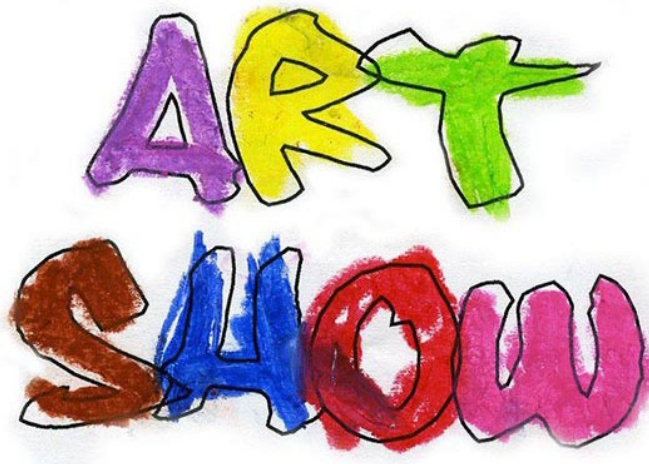
FUNDRAISING AND EVENT NEWS

Gift Stall

How it works

Where: School Hall - classes will be brought in during the day by their class teacher. Siblings can view the gifts at recess to work out who purchases what to avoid doubling up.

Cost: \$8.50 per gift (multiple gifts can be purchased; all gifts come in a gift bag; gifts also for Grandad).

How to purchase: Purchase your gift tickets online via Qkr! no later than 9am Tuesday 29th August. Students will then be issued "tickets" on the day of the stall, corresponding to the number of gifts pre-purchased. Students will then get to shop and choose gifts for Dad/Grandad.



DOUBLE THE FUN!

Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you so much for supporting our school to be the best it can be, especially through fundraising. This term we are fundraising with a Colour Splatacular School Fun Run with Australian Fundraising!

The Colour Splatacular School Fun Run will be on **Thursday 21st September 2023 from 1.30pm.** Parents/carers/grandparents are invited to watch and are also invited to join the students for a **pizza lunch beforehand from 12.30pm** (see Qkr! closer to the date).

- Students are encouraged to wear a WHITE shirt to show up the colour.
- Students will be given free sunglasses and a rainbow headband for the event and an iceblock afterwards.
- Students will be covered in non-toxic, biodegradable colour powder from head to toe.
- Students will also be covered in non-toxic water-based slime as well!
- Colour Powder is made of high-quality corn starch and permitted food colours. Safety data sheet is available upon request for Colour and Slime. Should any student wish to complete the course without getting coloured or slimed, please just let your classroom teacher know.
